SYNOPSIS OF MY STEWARDSHIP

We have been involved in fund generation from alumni/alumnae, corporate institutions and friends of the Department of Geology. The money realised during such campaigns has been used to upgrade our teaching and learning facilities and the environment which is now more user-friendly. We believe that benefactions can play a vital role in supporting the training of successive generations of students. Many of our alumni and alumnae were requested to join the history of philanthropic support and help us continue to transform the lives of our students. Through this focused charitable programme of fund raising, many have joined our community of graduates who are proud to know they are supporting one of the finest teaching, research and life opportunities in the geosciences in Nigeria.

The major achievements are summarized below:

- The *Association of Ibadan University Geologists* provided a state-of-the-art Petrological Microscope Laboratory in the Department in March 2007. The endowment, comprised two trinocular research microscopes and 21 binocular microscopes, with camera attachments, was valued at Ten Million, Five Hundred Thousand Naira only.
- We are improving the teaching, learning and research environment. The entire departmental complex was re-painted and refurbished in March 2008 at a cost of Two Million, One Hundred Thousand naira (₦2,100,000.00) which was raised from donations.
- We attracted the Esso Exploration and Production Nigeria Ltd to fund a Field Mapping Project, in conjunction with the Nigerian Geological Survey Agency. Through this initiative,
 - A brand-new 18-seater Toyota Hiace Field Vehicle, valued at Four Million Five Hundred Thousand naira (₦4,500,000.00) was donated to the Department in February 2008.
 - Our Senior Technologist was sponsored by Esso to undertake a week training course in Scotland in June 2008.
 - A Logitech Thin section Machine was supplied to the Department. A 30 KVA diesel generator, complemented with inverters/batteries were donated in July 2010. These are to be dedicated to the thin section machine, data processing workstation, the petrological microscope laboratory and the Office of the Head of Department.
 - We are benefiting to the tune of Seventy Five Million Naira (₦75,000,000.00) over the three-year duration of this project.
- Endowment of Prizes: The Department of Geology now has some 16 Prizes and awards generously endowed by alumni/alumnae and friends of the department at both the undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
- We created the *Department of Geology Occasional Publications Series* in March 2007, with three academic titles published.
- The *Mosobalaje Oyawoye Library*, named after the foremost African Geologist and first African Head of our Department, received a major facelift, in terms of computer hardware and software, recent journal collections and current books.

- We established the '*Department of Geology Thesis Support Grant Scheme*' in June 2010 for members of academic staff on their PhDs. This was designed as a token incentive for our academic staff who are on training positions to complete their research programme and become prospective postgraduate teachers. Two members of staff benefitted from the maiden award, which carries a monetary value of Fifty Thousand Naira (₦50,000.00) each.
- Three new members of the academic staff were employed. This has brought the total Faculty to 19, currently comprising 5 Professors/Readers, 6 Senior Lecturers and 8 Lecturer/Assistant Lecturers. A cartographer was also employed, bringing the total non-academic staff (technical and administrative) strength to 10.
- The Department secured '*Full Accreditation*' status from the NUC in 2008, with a Programme score of 89% compared with '*Interim Accreditation*' with a Programme Score of 61% in 2005.

1. STAFF MATTERS

It is gratifying to note that the University administration supported the department in the effort to recruit new members of staff. Three new academic positions were filled during the tenure (Table 1). The total academic staff position is now 19 which is a substantial improvement on the situation hitherto. The spread is satisfactory with 5 Professors/Readers, 6 Senior Lecturers and 8 Lecturers/Assistant Lecturers. Seventeen of the academic staff have PhDs while the other two are in various stages of completion of their doctoral research programmes. The members of staff are in different areas of specialization. The areas of dire needs that should be filled in the nearest future include Igneous Petrology, Metamorphic Petrology and Hydrogeology.

Efforts were made to encourage members of staff to develop themselves. A summary is given below:

1. **Mr Olawale Osinowo** was on study leave with pay at the research laboratory of the School of Earth and Environment, University of Leeds, United Kingdom, from March 2009 to February 2010, as part of his PhD programme. Part-funding of his trip was secured through the good offices of the Dean, Postgraduate School.
2. **Mr Mutiu Adeleye** was in China, under the sponsorship of the Chinese Academy of Sciences/Third World Academy of Sciences, as part of his PhD programme. He utilised the Fellowship at the State Key Laboratory of Organic Geochemistry, Guangzhou Institute of Geochemistry, from May 2009 to June 2010.
3. **Mr. Joseph A. Mofoluku**, Technologist I, attended a course in Precision Materials Technology at the laboratories of Logitech Ltd, in Scotland, United Kingdom, from 10 to 12 November 2008. The trip was wholly sponsored by ExxonMobil, under the Universities Partnering Programme.
4. We created the '**Department of Geology Thesis Writing Support Scheme**' through which members of academic staff registered for PhD are supported financially by the Department after registering the title of their PhD thesis. The value of the grant is Fifty Thousand Naira (₦50,000.00) only per beneficiary.

6. Mr O C Adeigbe benefitted from the MacArthur Re-entry Grant on the project ‘The high resolution Chemostratigraphy study of the cretaceous tertiary sediments of Chad Basin, Nigeria’.

There are currently 184 registered undergraduate students and 150 registered postgraduate students in the Department (Table 9). Our programmes are heavily subscribed. In the Faculty of Science the merit cut-off for our Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) has consistently remained one of the highest, surpassed only by Computer Science and Microbiology. For the 2009/10 entry, we ensured that the pass mark to enter Geology should be 50% and this should be maintained and improved upon in the years ahead. The fact remains that Geology is largely an applied science, for which reason it requires a very strong background in the basic science subjects notably Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology. These have been appropriately incorporated into our admission requirements as approved by Senate.

The postgraduate programmes are in Economic/Mining Geology, Mineral Exploration, Geochemistry, Applied Geophysics, Petroleum Geology and Sedimentology, and Engineering Geology/Hydrogeology.
